

A Call for Proposals

for Artwork honoring

Lady Julian of Norwich

*For the Lady Julian Chapel in St. Mark's on the Campus
Episcopal Church & Student Center*



Artists ages 19 and older are invited to submit proposals to create an artwork for the Lady Julian Chapel, an intimate worship space located in St. Mark's on the Campus Episcopal Church and Student Center.

LOCATION: The work is to hang on a wall in this small, lower level worship space used by church members of all ages (including young children). The space is also the site of the church's columbarium (a resting place for cremains). *You are welcome and encouraged to visit the Lady Julian Chapel during open hours, weekdays 9am to 3:30 pm (closed over the lunch hour, 12-1 pm) at 1309 R Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.*

MEDIA: Artist's choice

DIMENSIONS/SHAPE: Artist's choice, but not to exceed four feet in height or width; not to exceed six inches in depth

ARTIST'S HONORARIUM: \$1,000, to cover cost of materials and artist's services

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION DEADLINE: March 30, 2014

DEADLINE FOR INSTALLING ART IN THE SPACE: May 2, 2014

PROPOSAL FORMAT: 8.5 x 11 inches, to include a page with the artist's name and contact information; a page with a sketch, image, or rendering of the proposed artwork; and additional page(s) for a description that conveys the artist's concept for the work and the medium or media to be used

NOTE: All participating artists will be invited to a reception at the church on **March 30** where proposals will be on display. The selected artist will be notified **April 1**.

The work will make its public debut on **May 4** when the renovated chapel is blessed.

TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL: Mail your proposal to Lady Julian Art Proposals, c/o St. Mark's on the Campus Episcopal Church and Student Center, 1309 R Street, Lincoln NE 68501. Or bring your proposal to the church office in person during open hours, weekdays 9am to 3:30 pm (closed for lunch hour, 12-1 pm).

TO ENSURE RETURN OF A PROPOSAL: Include a self-addressed, stamped envelope, or come to the church office weekdays during open hours during April.
