University of Missouri-Kansas City Economics Department announces a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor. We seek candidates whose work complements the department's heterodox orientation. Applications from candidates with fields in any area are encouraged. Candidates working with quantitative empirical methods are especially encouraged.

This position is subject to University funding and approval. We value candidates with a commitment to improving access to higher education for historically underrepresented students. A Ph.D. completed by 08/01/2020 is required.

Review of applications begins November 22, 2019 and will continue until the position is filled.

Initial interviews will be conducted via video conference with second-round interviews either at the 2020 ASSA meetings in San Diego, or by video conference for candidates not attending the meetings.
